Timeline

12 Months from wedding date

Send Save the Dates

Whether digitally or by post its best to send these around the 12 months from your wedding date. This will allow your guests to plan any childcare/holidays with plenty of advance notice.

You may want to extend this to 16 months if you are having a destination wedding.

8 Months from wedding date

Start planning day invitation designs

6 Months from wedding date

Send Day Invitations

3 Months from wedding date

Send Evening Invitations

Its a good idea to send day and evening invitations seperatley as it will allow you to move any evening guests to day guests, if a day guest is unable to make it.

1-1.5 Months from wedding date

Print on the day stationery

It is best to leave menu and table plan printing to as close to the day as possible to allow for any changes.

consultation process

We would then confirm your booking and arrange a design consultation. Whether face to face, by zoom or email whatever you and your partner prefer.

I will begin to investigate your venue to have an idea of the layout/theme.

Once we have agreed the foundations of the style that you like, we will then work on your design.

We will send you a digital copy for you to review. We can then make any amends as required.

Once contact has been made we will look to provide you with a rough quote based on what you need. If happy to proceed we would secure your booking with a £100 deposit, which is taken off the final amount due.

During the consultation process we will discuss what you like/dont like. Your colour scheme and theme for the day. We can then start to suggest some card/material options, colours and finishing touches that will bring your stationery suite together.

Once the design is finalised and only when you are 100% happy, we will print. As I do all my printing in house I can turn this around quite quickly. I can usually have your invitations with you within 10 days from sign off. I can also send the invitations directly to your guest, or to you.
